Thank you for your interest in donating supplies to the Angkor Hospital for Children. We could not keep our doors open for all the children without the generous support of people like you. There is a very simple and specific set of procedures that you should follow in moving forward with the donation process. We know that all donations come from caring people who want to help but sometimes we cannot accept a donation for one of many possible reasons. If this is the case in regard to your donations, we would still like you to know how much we appreciate your generosity and effort and hope that suitable donations will become available in the future.

In order to determine if the donation is one we currently need and can accept, please fax or email the AHC Logistics Department a letter with a specific list of what you would like donate. We will let you know as soon as possible if we can accept it and when. We know your efforts are aimed at helping and would not want that energy wasted, so please check with us before beginning the donation process and we will let you know if the donation items are needed or we will help to redirect your energies.

If we can accept your generous donation please follow these procedures:

- The original invoice and original packing list should be faxed to us at least one month in advance of the Shipment's arrival in Cambodia. This allows us to prepare the paperwork needed for Cambodian Customs Without costing us any late fees or storage costs. (Please include: name, description, quantity, value and weight of all contents.)
- The seaway or airway bill should be faxed immediately upon your receipt from the shipper so that we may continue the above-mentioned processes on schedule.
- Please pay all shipping costs in advance.
- All medications must arrive in Cambodia with a minimum of 6 months until their expiration.

When in doubt please check with AHC Logistics Department before proceeding.

Once again on behalf of the hospital, its staff, and the children and families of Cambodia, I would like to thank you for your interest in making donations. We hope that what you would like to donate can arrive and be utilized by those who truly need it as easily, affordably and quickly as possible. I hope these procedures and regulations are all you need to move forward with your donation. If not, please email us with any further questions.
